Volunteer Opportunities

Saturday Afternoon

Carnival Games

Lucky Duck: There will be a little pool with ducks in it. Kids pick a duck and if it has an "S" they get a small prize, if it has an "M" they get a medium prize, if it has an "L" they get a large prize.

Plinko: Player drops 3 ping pong balls down the PLINKO board, attempting to get three of the balls to land in the same color. All three in one color gets a large prize, two in one color gets a medium prize, and all different colors gets a small prize.

Lollipop Tree: There will be a decorative board with lollipops stuck into it. Player chooses a lollipop, and if it has red on the bottom, they get a small prize, blue on the bottom is medium, and green on the bottom is large prize. Everyone gets to keep their lollipop. Note: Whoever is assigned to do this game, please make the odds of winning a large prize more difficult when filling and refilling the "tree." We want mostly small and medium prizes to be won.

Water Tic-Tac-Toe: There will be a pool with floating water noodles connected to make a Tic-Tac-Toe board. Player throws three sea creatures into the board/pool trying to get Tic-Tac-Toe. If the player doesn't get Tic-Tac-Toe s/he gets a small prize, and if the player does get Tic-Tac-Toe s/he gets a medium prize.

Wheel of Fortune: There will be a large wheel with 5 different colors on it. The player spins the wheel and wins the corresponding prize. Blue = small prize, Red = medium prize, Orange = large prize, Green = spin again, Purple = piece of candy.

Leap Frog: There will be a catapult for 3 rubber frogs. Participants will have 3 chances to launch one frog at a time. They will do this by hitting the catapult with a rubber mallet trying to launch the frogs into a box at the end of the table. No frogs in the box = small prize, any of the frogs in the box = medium prize.

Quack Attack: Participants will have 3 chances to knock down as many rubber ducks as possible out of 6 total ducks. 0 - 1 duck = small prize, 2 - 4 ducks = medium prize, 5 - 6 ducks = large prize.

Over Under: Players will roll 6 racquetballs down the board into numbered slots. If the total of all the numbers is over 30 or under 11 the player wins a medium prize. All other participants win a small prize.

Finish Line: Players choose a plush animal to race and line them up on the board at the start line each representing a number 1-6. Five dice will be rolled and if the player's number comes up on the dice they move their animal one square towards the finish line. First person to the finish line wins the animal that they chose to play with. All other participants win a small prize for participating. Note: Put 6 animals aside so if you run out of them, you will still have something for the kids to race with. If they win, they'll get a large prize.

Saucer Toss: Participants will get 5 coins to try to toss onto the saucers. No coins on the saucers gets a small prize, any coins on the saucers gets a medium prize.

Chicken Chuck: Players will get 3 chickens to try to chuck into the "pot." 0-1 chicken in gets a small prize, 2-3 chickens in gets a medium prize.

Potty Toss: Participants will get 3 balls to try to toss into the potty. 0-1 ball in gets a small prize, 2 balls in gets a medium prize, 3 balls in gets a large prize.

Dunk Tank: Player will get 3 balls to try to knock the person into the tank. If not successful in knocking person into tank, player gets a small prize. If player knocks person into tank, player gets a medium prize.

Mini Golf: Allow participants to play through the nine-hole mini golf course.

Trash Can Challenge: Three garbage cans marked small, medium & large will be set up in front of the player. They will have 3 chances to bounce a racquetball into the garbage cans starting with the largest can (marked small) and working up to the smallest can (marked large). However far they get will represent the prize that they win. (Ex: Large trash can marked "small" = small prize.)

SpongeBob Lob: Players will get 4 balls to toss at the Velcro game board. Small prize is 0 to 100 points, medium prize is 100 to 200 points, large prize is over 200 points.

Target Drop: Participants will get 3 coins to drop into 2 buckets. If the player gets no coins or one coin in the small bucket, they get a small prize. If they get one coin in the medium bucket, they get a medium prize. If they get both coins in both buckets, they get a large prize.

Prize Walk: Numbers will be on the ground in a circle. Music is played while participants walk around the circle. Participants stop when the music stops. A number is drawn and the person standing on that number wins a door prize.

Sales

Ticket Sales: Sell tickets, wristbands, and/or punch cards for the games and alcoholic beverages.

Raffle: Sell raffle tickets and post winners.

Beverage Servers: Serve drinks.

Concession Worker: Assist with food and non-alcoholic drink sales.

Inflatable Games

Airborne Adventure: A.A. has an inner capsule where the guest is harnessed beneath a parachute. A flick of the switch and the rider moves skyward suspended from the parachute that lifts to almost 20 ft. for a bird's eye view. 175 lb. weight limit.

Moonwalk: This size can hold five small bouncers as they jump, bounce, and spring into safe and secure play.

Velcro Wall: Participants will wear a Velcro "sticky suit" jump up and down on the inflated bouncy base then fling themselves onto the Velcro Wall. There are adult and youth suits.

Obstacle Course: Allow participant to enter the course and make sure they make it through in a timely manner.

4-in-1 Combo: Guests will climb over and crawl under a group of air filled obstacles, pass along the moonbounce section that includes a basketball hoop, climb a hill and finally glide down a slide to finish.

Slide Giant: The slide generates mega speed as the sliders swoop down and finish with a flourish.

Rocky Mountain Climbing Wall: This is a multi-sided mountain complete with safety harnesses. Climbers of all ages can climb close to 28 ft. above the ground. (Inflatable company providing 2 workers.)

Other Activities & Duties

Temporary Tattoo Station: Apply temporary tattoos according to instructions.

Logistics: Help maintain cleanliness of the park and assist with needs as they come up such as bringing more prizes to specific games or giving volunteers breaks.

Activities

These activities are available for kids to utilize while waiting for the Movie to begin.

Bounce Castle: Children can jump around in the enclosed bouncer.

Joust: Attendant will help participants put on helmets and get onto pedestals. The inflatable will be taken down before it starts to get dark.

Hot Air Balloon Assistant: Assist with the hot air balloon rides as instructed by balloon owner.

Sell Glow Necklaces: Glow necklaces are \$1 each.
